TECHNICAL SITE VISIT TO INDUSTRY WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITIES ON JURONG ISLAND BY SEMBCORP

14 September 2016, 1.30pm – 5.00pm

SWA will be organising the technical visit to Industry Wastewater Treatment Facilities on Jurong Island by Sembcorp.

Sembcorp owns and operates water facilities across 5 continents, from the supply of potable and industrial water to industrial wastewater treatment, water reclamation and desalination. Sakra is where Sembcorp started the commercial operation of its first wastewater treatment plant in 1997. Today, the wastewater treatment facilities at Sakra are capable of treating high organic concentration industrial wastewater with chemical oxygen demand of up to 19,000 mg/litre and high salinity industrial wastewater with salinity of up to 50,000 mg/litre. The Sakra facilities also provide an extensive range of industrial water products including demineralised water, industrial water, raw water, chilled water, seawater cooling and firewater.

Banyan at Jurong Island is where the new investors in specialty chemicals are located. Sembcorp commenced the operation of its latest industrial wastewater treatment plant at Banyan in August 2012. Besides wastewater treatment, Sembcorp has also invested in multi-utilities facilities at Banyan, similar to Sakra, to supply steam and other site services to the customers in Banyan.

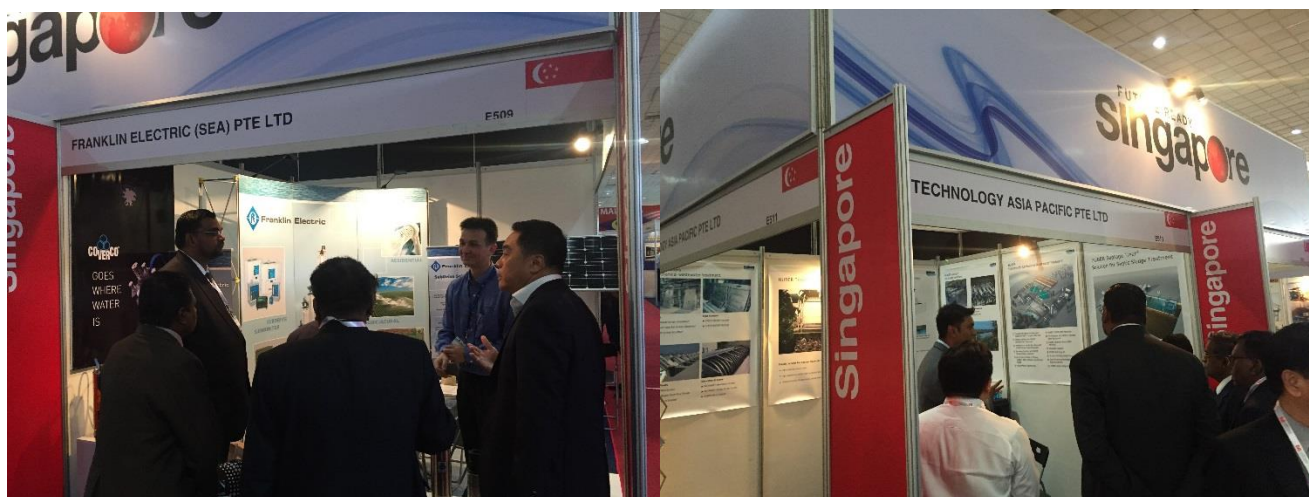
