# 29th Singapore Water Industry Nite

The 29<sup>th</sup> Singapore Water Industry Nite sponsored by CH2M Hill was held at the WaterHub on 18 November 2016. The evening started with the presentation of Safety Recognition Award by Mr Subbu Kanakasabapathy, Managing Director, Asia Pacific Region of CH2M Hill to 15 Safety Superstars nominated by SWA member companies. This was followed by information on the upcoming activities of SWA as well as announcement on new PUB upcoming projects. The event ended with the usual dinner and networking which was well received by over 120 members and invited guests.







#### **Technical Site Visit to Cleantech Park**

On 3 November, 26 participants attended the technical visit to Cleantech Park organised by SWA. The visit included a guided tour of Water Management features in Cleantech One — a hotbed for environmental innovations with some of the most technologically-

advanced sustainable water and energy management systems. Participants also visited the first Water SMART Blue Building in Singapore. This eco-friendly commercial building has been successfully operating its own black water recycling system since June 2016.





## **SWA Organised Singapore Pavilions at Overseas Trade Shows**

#### Myanwater 2016

For the fourth time, SWA organised the Singapore pavilion at Myanwater 2016 on 3-5 November 2016 in Yangon, Myanmar. As one of the largest country pavilions at this mega water event, the Singapore pavilion occupied a total floor space of 138 sqm, where 11 companies showcased their latest products and services.

The Minister of Planning and Finance, H.E. U Myint Thaung, together with other local government agencies and societies including Yangon City Development, Myanmar Engineering Society, Yangon Electricity Supply Corporation and Mandalay City Development, visited the Singapore Pavilion in the morning of 3 November after the Opening Ceremony.

A reception was held thereafter at the pavilion to provide networking opportunities for the Singapore exhibitors and invited guests.

#### Vietwater 2016

For the ninth time, SWA organised a Singapore pavilion at Vietwater 2016 from 9-11 November in Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam. The pavilion consisted of nine Singapore companies and occupied an exhibition space of 102 sqm. The three-day exhibition was a good opportunity for the companies to showcase their water expertise and solutions, to source for innovative technology, to trade with solution providers and to share best practices as well as stay up-to-date with the latest global trends. The show attracted good visitorship with adequate publicity by the Show Organiser.

The SWA Networking Reception welcomed the Chairman of VWSA, Mr Cao Lai Quang and groups of local and overseas government officials on the second day of the show.
