TECHNICAL SITE VISIT TO FLOATING SOLAR PHOTOVOLTAIC TESTBED BY SERIS *3 November 2017*

Organised by SWA, 21 participants visited the Floating Solar Photovoltaic Testbed at Tengeh Reservoir, which is a first of its kind and the world's largest floating solar photovoltaic cell test-bed. It comprises of 10 different types of floating structures and PV modules, each generating around 100 kWp, which allows the comparison of PV installations' performance against the rooftop mounted systems. In addition, the testbed also features an active water cooling system, as well as a rooftop reference system. Due to Singapore's land-scarcity and location in the tropics, the floating PV is a highly promising project.

33rd SINGAPORE WATER INDUSTRY NITE *30 November 2017, e2i west*

The 33rd Singapore Water Industry Nite was held on 30 November at e2i west. Sponsored by UES Holdings Pte Ltd, the evening programme began with sharing sessions by UES Holdings, updates on the new PUB e-invoice submission & payment via interbank GIRO as well as presentation by e2i services and grants. 
VIETWATER 2017
