### **TECHNOLOGY MISSION TRIP TO GERMANY**

14 - 20 May 2018, Messe München

In conjunction with IFAT 2018 Munich, a technology mission trip to Germany was organised by SWA. The main objective of the mission was to visit IFAT, the world's leading trade fair for water and sewage technologies.

A Singapore delegation of 20, which comprised of six water companies as well as representatives from PUB, EDB, Enterprise Singapore (formerly known as International Enterprise Singapore) and SWA, attended the mission. The Singapore to Germany Ambassador Mr Laurence Bay also joined the delegation and welcome dinner.

The main highlight of the five-day programme was a B2B Matching session, which was well attended by 34 foreign delegates and nine Singapore delegates. There were 39 pre-arranged meetings and 15 adhoc meetings, of which nine MOUs were signed. Delegates were generally satisfied with the mission as they got to acquire new business contacts, gained more market insights and developed cross-border business collaborations. In addition, the delegates also visited WWTP Grueneck Neufahrn (State-Owned WWTP) and WWTP Oberschleissheim (Aerzen) for an in-depth understanding of overseas WWTP operations and smart remote monitoring system.









# **TECHNICAL VISIT TO PULAU SEMAKAU LANDFILL**

8 May 2018, Semakau Landfill

Semakau Landfill was commissioned in April 1999 and is Singapore's only landfill for waste disposal. Ash from the incineration plants and non-incinerable waste, such as construction and renovation debris, are disposed at the landfill.

The landfill covers a total area of 350 hectares and has a capacity of 28 million m³ when filled to the perimeter bund level with permanent capping. The bund is lined with impermeable membrane and a layer of marine clay to ensure that the water collected in the landfill due to rainfall and the filing of ash is contained within the area and treated at a wastewater treatment plant. Other ancillary facilities were also built on the island to ensure self-sustainability of the landfill operation. The participants were briefed on wastewater

management in Semakau Landfill and visited the site to understand how solid waste and sewage sludge are disposed there.
