The success of the tournament was a testament of the support received and belief in SWA's mission in developing a vibrant and dynamic Singapore Water Industry.

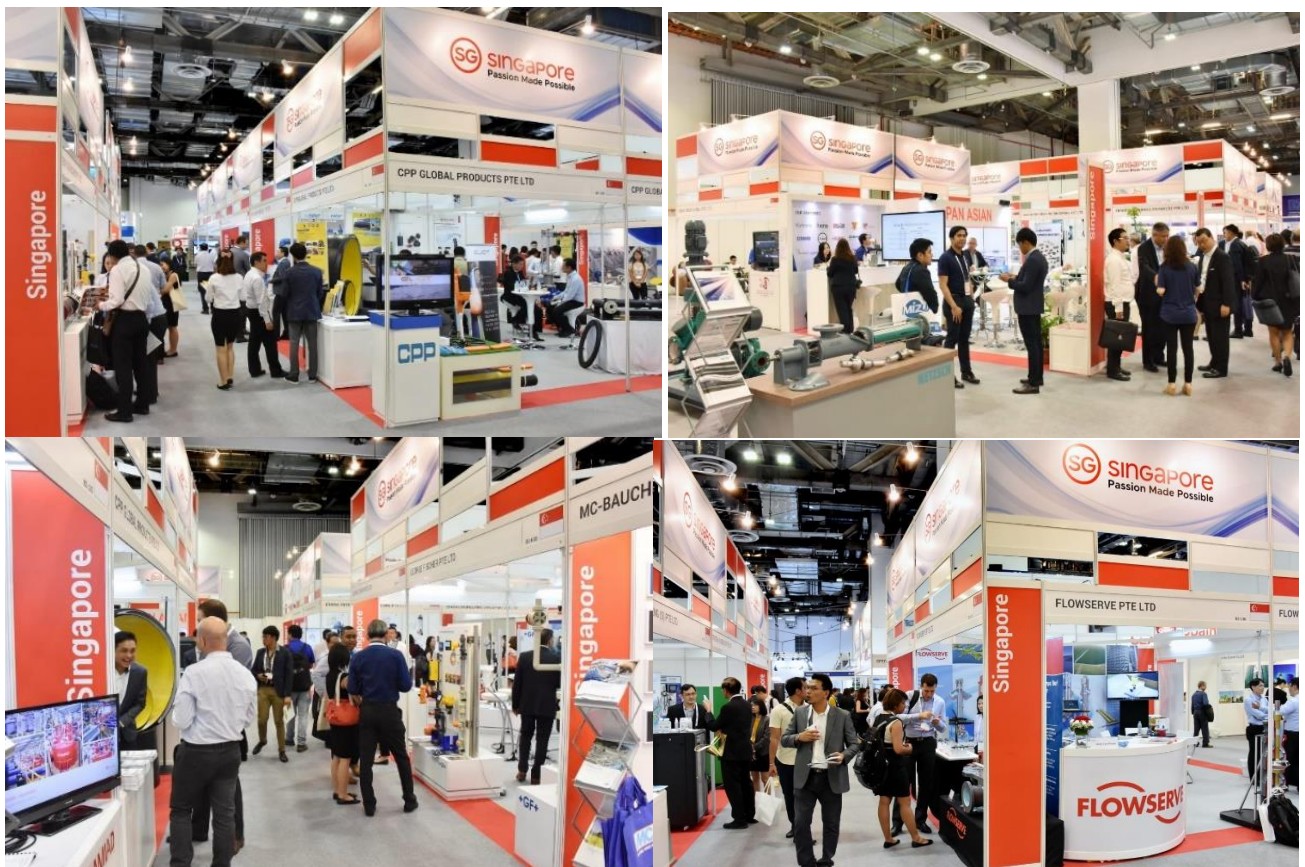


SINGAPORE INTERNATIONAL WATER WEEK 2018

9 – 11 July 2018, Marina Bay Sands Singapore

The 8th Singapore International Water Week was held in conjunction with the 6th World Cities Summit and the 4th CleanEnviro Summit Singapore, from 9 – 11 July 2018 at the Sands Expo and Convention Centre, Marina Bay Sands in Singapore. The Singapore International Water Week (SIWW) is the global platform to share and co-create innovative water solutions. The biennial event gathers over 1,000 exhibitors from the global water industry to share best practices, showcase the latest technologies and tap business opportunities over an expo space of 32,640 sqm.

SWA organized the Singapore pavilion of 32 exhibitors occupying 696 sqm at the expo; co-organised the SWA-APDA Joint Conference with APDA (Asia Pacific Desalination Association), partook in the Singapore Business Forum and supported business networking sessions with Israel and US Embassy as well as EU Business Avenue.
