The world's limited water supply is threatened by many factors — rapid urbanisation, population growth, industrialisation and now, increasingly, climate change. For an island city state like Singapore, water supply is an existential issue. Over the decades, Singapore has made significant investments in innovative methods of water resource management and technology, and maximised resource efficiency and recovery. These strategies have enabled us to ensure a sustainable and secure water supply for our people.
